Brushes: Watercolor brushes come in a wide variety of shapes, sizes, materials and prices; any middle quality brand will work. I like Simmons, Escoda, Lowell Cornell, Zen.

Palette:

White palette with wells and cover (I love Masterson palette, you can get it on amazon)

Paint:

Please get professional grade paint, the difference is significant and will effect the look of your painting (higher pigmentation, brighter, truer colors) any professional paint brand, Winsor Newton, M Graham, Sennelier, Daniel Smith (great value!), Holbein and any others that are professional grade.

- Ultramarine blue
- Cobalt blue
- Alizarin Crimson
- Permanent Rose
- New Gamboge or Indian Yellow
- Aureolin
- Burnt sienna
- Sepia
- Neutral Tint
- Winsor Blue (optional)

Accessories:

- Roll of paper towels
- Masking tape (to hold your paper to the board if it is not a block)
- Sea sponge (optional)
- Plastic container for water (old Tupperware)
- Pencil, kneaded eraser
- Toothbrush
- Small spray bottle

Please have a board to adhere your paper to if it is not a block. Masonite, Foamcore (works fine, and is less expensive and light)
